## Get Angry

Carrboro's 3 nice large green parks are all on the "good" side of Main Street. For decades town officials have regarded our meadow & woods to be their private land piggy-bank that they can use for whatever project they are considering, and without the kinds of warning and consultation with neighbors that they would require of a private developer (even though we are the co-owners of it). In 1989 the new post office nearly ended up here and later this tract was considered for the library, public works maintenance yard, and affordable housing. In 2016 the Google shed in the woods was rammed down our throats with no warning. None of this would have been considered if this was a single family home neighborhood.

## Carrboro Connects

This "lah-dee-dah" community planning process is producing an aspirational 200+ page comprehensive plan up thru 2042. But its lofty principles will not be applied by Town Hall unless we speak up. The Tuesday Council hearing will receive feedback on the 2nd CC draft.

## Solution for Cemetery

Some of our remaining long term local families wish to hold to the traditional burials that are part of their culture. To arrange for a graceful winding down of the Davie Road cemetery the Town should tighten up rules so the remaining plots are steered to the families most connected to this cemetery. At the same time the Town should buy 3 beautiful acres for a new cemetery only 6 minutes away on Damascus Church Road.
